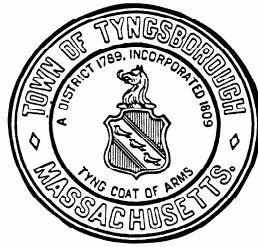

To either of the Constables of the Town of Tyngsborough, Massachusetts, in the County of Middlesex:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town of Tyngsborough, qualified to vote in elections and Town affairs, to meet at the Tyngsborough Elementary School, 250 Westford Road in said Tyngsborough on the twenty-fifth day of March, in the year two thousand eight next at 7:00 o'clock in the evening then and there to act on the following articles:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or appropriate by transfer from available funds a sum of money to the Highway Union salary, wages, and expense accounts to fund the collective bargaining agreement with SEIU, Local 888, or take any other action relative thereto.

The Finance Committee recommends approval of this article and that \$12,250 be appropriated by transfer from Other Salaries Account #122-5103, and that \$1,025 be appropriated from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings, for the Highway Union salary, wages, and expense accounts, to fund fiscal year 2008 of a three year agreement between the Town and SEIU, Local 888.

The Board of Selectmen recommends approval.

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or appropriate by transfer from available funds a sum of money to the Clerical Union salary, wages, and expense accounts to fund the collective bargaining agreement with SEIU, Local 888, or take any other action relative thereto.

The Finance Committee recommends approval of this article and that \$11,515 be appropriated by transfer from Other Salaries Account #122-5103 for the Clerical Union salary, wages, and expense accounts to fund fiscal year 2008 of a three year agreement between the Town and SEIU, Local 888.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or appropriate by transfer from available funds a sum of money to the Mid-Management Union salary, wages, and expense accounts to fund the collective bargaining agreement with SEIU, Local 888, or take any other action relative thereto.

The Finance Committee recommends approval of this article and that \$10,750 be appropriated by transfer from Other Salaries Account #122-5103, and that \$2,670 be appropriated from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings, for the Mid-Management Union salary, wages, and expense accounts, to fund fiscal year 2008 of a three year agreement between the Town and SEIU, Local 888.

The Board of Selectmen recommends approval.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or appropriate by transfer from available funds a sum of money to the Police and Dispatchers Union salary, wages, and expense accounts to fund the collective bargaining agreement with NEPBA, Local 8, or take any other action relative thereto.

The Finance Committee recommends approval of this article and that \$52,800 be appropriated by transfer from Other Salaries Account #122-5103 for the Police and Dispatchers Union salary, wages, and expense accounts to fund fiscal year 2008 of a three year agreement between the Town and NEPBA, Local 8.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate and/or appropriate by transfer from available funds a sum of money to supplement various municipal government accounts for fiscal year 2008, or take any other action relative thereto.

The Finance Committee recommends that the Town transfer the following sums of money to supplement the following accounts in FY08:

- \$2,561 from Other Salaries Acct. 122-5103 to supplement:
\$1,327 in the Town Collector Salary Acct. #146-5100 so that the salary of the elected Town Collector is fixed at \$54,389
\$1,234 in the Town Clerk Salary Acct. #160-5100 so that the salary of the elected Town Clerk is fixed at \$50,577

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to amend Article 27 of the Special Town Meeting of October 10, 2006 regarding the parcel at 76 Frost Road, currently known as the Tyngsborough Campgrounds, by expanding its purpose for not only cleaning up of the parcel but also for planning, design, and construction, in accordance with the requirements of the Community Preservation Committee, Board of Selectmen, Conservation Commission, and Board of Health, or take any other action relative thereto.

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from existing Community Preservation Budgeted Reserve, Unreserved Fund Balance, and/or borrow a sum of money, for the purpose of purchasing a parcel of land of approximately 1.5 acres and buildings at 86 Frost Road, (Assessors Map 25-8, Lot 0), from the owner, Martin E. Kelly of 104 Frost Road, including the payment of any and all costs incidental and related thereto, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to appropriate by transfer from available funds and/or borrow a sum of monies for the purpose of paying additional costs of installing a holding tank, oil/water separator, drain(s), and vehicle wash system for the handling of oil, grease, and water at the Highway Garage, all costs of any necessary engineering, plans, storm water pollution prevention plans and permit applications, and for the payment of any and all other costs incidental and related thereto, which amount shall be expended in addition to the \$200,000 previously appropriated by the Town for this purpose, all of which shall be expended at the direction of the Board of Selectmen, or take any other action relative thereto.

Motion. That the sum of \$30,000 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of paying additional costs of installing a holding tank, oil/water separator, drain(s), and vehicle wash system for the handling of oil, grease, and water at the Highway Garage, all costs of any necessary engineering, plans, storm water pollution prevention plans and permit applications, and for the payment of any and all other costs incidental and related thereto, which amount shall be expended in addition to the \$200,000 previously appropriated by the Town for this purpose, all of which shall be expended at the direction of the Board of Selectmen, and that to meet this appropriation, the Treasurer, with the approval of the Selectmen, is authorized to borrow said amount under and pursuant to Chapter 44, Section 7(3A) of the General Laws, or pursuant to any other enabling authority, and to issue bonds or notes of the Town therefor.

And you are hereby directed to serve this Warrant, by posting attested copies thereof at the Town Hall, Kendall Road Fire Station No. 1, Flint's Convenience Store, Lakeview Avenue Community Center, and Lakeview Avenue Fire Station No. 2, in said Town, fourteen (14) days at least before the time of holding said meeting.

HEREOF FAIL NOT, and make due return the Warrant, with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at the time and place of meeting, aforesaid.
